EIGHTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY having filed  
 with the Railroad Commission a statement showing that it has ex-  
 pended for construction purposes during the month of January 1918,  
 the sum of \$156,206.32, and it appearing that the sum so expended  
 was for proper capital purposes and that applicant is entitled  
 to expend \$117,154.74 of the proceeds from the sale of \$3,000,000.  
 of bonds referred to in sub-division "A" of Condition 3 of the  
 Order in Decision Number 4468, dated July 19, 1917, to finance  
 in part said construction expenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern  
 California Edison Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to  
 use \$117,154.74 of the proceeds from the sale of \$3,000,000.00

of bonds referred to in sub-division "A" of Condition 3 of the Order in Decision Number 4468, dated July 19, 1917, to pay in part for its construction expenditures during the month of January, 1918.
