FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission, on September 26, 1916, by its Decision No. 3698 in the above entitled proceeding, granted the Reedley Telephone Company an extension of time to and including December 31, 1917, under the conditions specified in its order, for the completion of the reconstruction of its lines as provided in Chapter 499, Laws of 1911, as amended by Chapter 600, Laws of 1915.

Potitioner failed to complete this work by the required time and did not request a further extension until after the above extension of time had expired. When applicant became aware that it would be unable to comply with the Commission's order, it should have immediately requested a modification of same instead of waiting until the matter was called to its attention by the Commission.

A further extension of time to and including June 30, 1918, within which to complete said work, having been requested; and it appearing to the Commission upon investigation that petitioner will be able to complete this work by April 15, 1918, and,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Reedley Telephone Company shall reconstruct its existing system so as to comply March, 1918.
