SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

The attention of the Railroad Commission having been directed to the fact that quite a large number of applicants for water from Petitioner for the irrigating season of 1918 are having unexpected and unanticipated difficulties in securing rights of way for laterals to reach their respective lands, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which applicants for water from Petitioner herein for the irrigating season of 1918, in instances in which the applications have not been granted in full, must notify the utility in writing whether the assignment is accepted and, if so, the particular land on which the water is to be applied, be and the same is hereby extended to and including 20 days instead of 10 days, as heretofore ordered, subsequent to the mailing of notice of such assignment by the utility.
