FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS the Railroad Commission by Decision Num-
ber 5100, dated February 4, 1918, authorized Western States Gas
and Electric Company to issue \$178,000.00 of its 7 per cent pre-
ferred capital stock and to use the proceeds from the sale of
said stock to pay current indebtedness as hereafter authorized by
the Railroad Commission in a supplemental order or orders; and

WHEREAS Western States Gas and Electric Company
reports that it has received from the sale of said stock an amount
in excess of \$17,500.00; and

WHEREAS Western States Gas and Electric Company
asks the Railroad Commission to use \$17,500.00 of the proceeds
from the sale of its 7 per cent preferred stock to pay a note
of \$17,500.00 due The Seaboard National Bank of San Francisco
in order to finance in part its construction expenditures to
October 31, 1917;

And it appearing to the Railroad Commission that applicant's request is reasonable and should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western States Gas and Electric Company be, and it is hereby, granted authority to use \$17,500.00 of the proceeds from the sale of its preferred stock issued pursuant to Decision Number 5100, dated February 4, 1918, to pay a \$17,500.00 note due The Seaboard National Bank of San Francisco; said payment to be considered as financing in part applicant's construction expenditures incurred prior to October 31, 1917;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 5100, dated February 4, 1918, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
