When petitioner became aware that it worla be wnebie to comply with the Commission's order, it shoria have imediatoly requestea a modification of same instead of waiting tintil the matter was cailed to its attertion by the Commission.

A further extension of time to and snciuding August 正, 1918, within which to complete said work, hes been regrested. It appears upon investigation that petitioner will bo able to compiete this work oy drue 30, 1918.

IT IS EFREBY ORDHRED that the time within which Corona Eome Telephone and Telegraph Company shall reconstruct its existing system so as to comply completely with the proVisions of Chapter 499, Laws of 1911, as amended by Cingtor 600. Laws of 2915, is hereby further extended to and incarding June 30, 1918. The final progress report of petitioner shall be fled with the Rajirosd Commission on or before July 25, 2918.
