O R D E R

Peoples Auto Bus Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Sacramento and Mills Station.

Applicant proposes to operate fourteen round trips daily between Sacramento and Mills Station, serving the United States Aviation Training School at Mills Station, and to increase the schedule in accordance with the demands of traffic in future. It is proposed to charge a fare of thirty-five cents between Sacramento and Mills Station.

The equipment proposed to be used in this service consists of four twenty-passenger Atterbury auto busses, each of forty-horse power, licenses for which have not yet been obtained from the State Motor Vehicle Department.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Peoples Auto Bus Company, a corporation, of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Sacramento and Mills Station, in the County of Sacramento; provided, that this declaration shall not become effective until the applicant herein shall have received a supplemental order from the Railroad Commission reciting that there has been filed herein certified copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento and by the Commission of the City of Sacramento in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
