BY THE COMMISSION.

O R D E R

Stanley C. Harrell has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that the public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between Plymouth and Sacramento and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to operate one round trip daily, except Sunday, and to call for and deliver goods within the city limits of Plymouth and the old city limits of Sacramento, and to serve the intermediate communities at Forest Home, Bridge House, Slough House and Walsh Station.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule filed as an exhibit attached to the application in this proceeding.

The equipment proposed to be used on the desired route consists of a Chalmers A. L. A. M., Truck with rating of forty eight horse-power and with a two ton "Truxton" attachment. License has been issued by the State Motor Vehicle Department under No. 255187.

The proposed service will give direct connection for

freight shipments from Sacramento to Plymouth, present service being by rail from Sacramento to Iona or Latrobe and a team or truck haul to Plymouth.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Stanley C. Harrell of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between Sacramento and Plymouth and intermediate points; provided that this declaration shall not become effective until said Stanley C. Harrell shall have received from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Stanley C. Harrell has filed herein certified copies of permits from the Board of Supervisors of Sacramento and Amador Counties, the City Commission of the City of Sacramento and the Board of Trustees of the City of Plymouth, same issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
