ORDER

M. F. Sanclemente, B. H. Steele and F. V. Sanclemente, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of Beamon Truck Line, having petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by them of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between San Diego and Tia Juana and intermediate points.

Applicants propose to operate a schedule of one round trip daily between San Diego and Tia Juana and one round trip daily between San Diego and San Ysidro, and to serve the communities of National City, Palm City, Nestor and San Ysidro and the Holderness, Lonsteht, Peavey, Thompson and Christofferson Dairy Ranches.

Applicants propose to charge rates in accordance with a schedule attached as an exhibit to the application in this proceeding.

The equipment to be used in the proposed service consists of one Denby Truck, 22 horse-power, capacity of one ton, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under No. 393640 and

one Moore Truck, 42 horse power, 2 1/2 ton capacity, license for which has been applied for to the State Motor Vehicle Department.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by M. F. Sanclemente, B. H. Steele and F. V. Sanclemente, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of "Beamon Truck Line" of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between San Diego and Tia Juana, California: provided, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Sanclemente, Steele and Sanclemente shall have procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Sanclemente, Steele and Sanclemente have filed herein certified copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of San Diego County, the City Council of the City of San Diego, and the Board of Trustees of the City of National City; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be transferred or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicles may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicants herein or is leased by such applicants under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
