ORDER

Fred Daggett has applied to the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Pepperwood and Dyerville and intermediate points, all in Humboldt County.

Applicant proposes to operate one round trip, daily except Sunday, and to serve the communities at Dyerville, Englewood, Holmes and Pepperwood.

Applicant proposes to charge fares in accordance with a schedule filed as an exhibit attached to the application in this proceeding.

The equipment proposed to be used in the service consists of one Cole 6 cylinder Automobile, 48 horse-power, with a seating capacity of seven passengers, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 37548.

Permit has been secured from the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt as required by the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917, and certified copy of same has been filed with the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which

a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Fred Daggett of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Pepperwood and Dyerville, and intermediate points all in the County of Humboldt; provided that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
