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In the matter of the application of LUCERNE WATER COMPANY, a corporation, for an order for the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity. ) Application No. 2552.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

LUCERNE WATER COMPANY having applied to the Commission for certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require it to irrigate from its present system an additional contiguous area of some 260 acres to that described in the original order, and it appearing from the testimony presented at the hearing of Application No. 3574, for authority to issue stock, that applicant's pumping plants and system/now sufficient to furnish 3 acre feet of water during each irrigation season upon 5000 acres of irrigable land and that no other public utility water company is engaged in supplying such irrigation.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require said Lucerne Water Company to irrigate in addition to the lands described in the order herein entered September 26, 1916 the following described lands, all located in Siskiyou County, California, to-wit:

All that portion of west half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Sec. 9, Twp. 44 N., R. 5, W.M.D.M., lying and being between the present county road and the third lift ditch of the Lucerne Water Company, comprising 30.89 acres, more or less, of irrigable land and 2.42 acres of irrigable land in the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of

Sec. 16, Twp. 44 N., R. 5 W.M.D.M.

All irrigable portions of the south half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Sec. 16, Twp. 44 N., R. 5 W.M.D.M., lying and being below the third lift ditch of the Lucerne Water Company, and comprising 110 acres of irrigable land, more or less. This acreage does not include that taken in by the present County road or isolated land above said ditch.

All those portions of the southeast quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Sec. 9, Twp. 44 N., R. 5 W.M.D.M., and the Northeast quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Sec. 9, and the Southeast quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Southwest quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Sec. 9, lying and being under the third lift ditch of the Lucerne Water Company and above the second lift ditch of said Lucerne Water Company, and west of the present County Road, none of said land lying below or east of said County Road, and comprising 116 acres of irrigable land, more or less, and 5 acres, more or less, of land that is not to be irrigated, but includes waste land and those portions used by range buildings, residence, corrals, etc.
