FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

Good Cause Appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition "4" of the order
in Decision Number 5281, dated April 5, 1918, reading:--

"The proceeds obtained from the sale of the
bonds or notes herein authorized to be issued
shall be deposited by applicant in a special
fund and used to finance in whole or in part its
expenditures upon its San Pablo project from and
after January 1, 1918. No part of said pro-
ceeds shall be expended until applicant has
filed with the Railroad Commission a statement
showing its expenditures on said project since
January 1, 1918, and has obtained from the Rail-
road Commission a supplemental order authorizing
the use of the proceeds from the sale of the
bonds or notes herein authorized to be issued."

be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to read:--

"The proceeds obtained from the sale of the bonds or notes herein authorized to be issued shall be deposited by applicant in a special fund and used to finance in whole or in part its expenditures upon its San Pablo project from and after January 1, 1918, set forth in the opinion in Decision Number 5281, dated April 5, 1918, provided that on or before the twenty-fifth day of each month applicant shall file with the Railroad Commission a report showing the progress made in the construction of its San Pablo project, a detailed statement of the expenditures during said month and the amount paid thereon."
