which applicant will issue the notes herein authorized or the notes issued pursuant to the authorized or the notes issued pursuant to the authority herein granted, shall contain a provision authorizing East Bay Water Company to pay said notes at its option in lieu of cash in first mortgage bonds at not less than 92-1/2 per cent of their face value, plus accrued interest, or, in lieu thereof, East Bay Water Company shall conclude, in writing, before issuing notes, an agreement for the sale of so many of its first mortgage bonds at not less than 92-1/2 per cent of their face value, plus accrued interest, as will produce the funds necessary to pay the notes issued."
