ORDER

E. L. McConnel has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity requires the operation by him of an automobile express and messenger service as a common carrier between Paso Robles and San Luis Obispo.

Applicant proposes to operate on a schedule of one round trip, daily except Sunday, and to serve as intermediate points the communities at Santa Margarita, Atascadero and Templeton. The rates proposed are in accordance with a schedule filed as Exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding.

The equipment proposed to be used in this service consists of one Ford Automobile with express body, 22 horse power, capacity 1/2 ton, license for which has been applied for to the State Motor Vehicle Department.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public

convenience and necessity requires the operation by E. L. Mc
Connell of an automobile service as a common carrier of express,
light freight and messages between Paso Robles and San Luis
Obispo and intermediate points; provided, that this declaration
shall not become effective until said E. L. McConnell shall have
secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein
reciting that said E. L. McConnell has filed herein certified
copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of San Luis
County
Obispo, the Board of Trustees of the City of El Paso de Robles
and the Council of the City of San Luis Obispo, in accordance
with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917,
and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein
granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written
consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer
has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no passenger may be carried
under the rights conferred by this certificate and that no
vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle
is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant
under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the
Railroad Commission.
