FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission, on September 26, 1916, by its Decision No. 3704 in the above entitled proceeding, having granted the Home Telephone Company of Covina an extension of time to and including June 30, 1918, for complying completely with the provisions of Chapter 499, Laws of 1911, as amended by Chapter 600, Laws of 1915, on condition that at least one-half of the reconstruction work necessary to be done should be completed on or before June 30, 1917, and the entire work on or before June 30, 1918, and application having been made for a further extension of time within which to complete said work to June 30, 1919, and,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Home Telephone Company of Covina shall reconstruct its existing system so as to comply completely with the provisions of Chapter 499, Laws of 1911, as amended by Chapter 600, Laws of 1915, is hereby further extended to and including June 30, 1919. Except as hereby modified, petitioner shall file with the Railroad Commission progress reports in the

manner and at the times heretofore directed in Decision No. 3704.
