ORDER

Wallace B. Twitchell has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and packages between St. Helena and Walters Springs.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule filed as Exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding. Applicant proposes to operate on a schedule of one round-trip daily and to serve the intermediate communities at Toland House, Union College, White Cottages, Aetna Springs and Pope Valley Store.

The equipment proposed to be used in this service consists of the following:

- 1 - 12 passenger 22 H. P., 1 ton capacity automobile
- 1 - 14 passenger 22 H. P., 1 ton capacity automobile
- 1 - 5 passenger 22 H. P., 1200 lb. capacity automobile
- 1 - 5 passenger 22 H. P., 1200 lb. capacity automobile

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Wallace B. Twitchell of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and packages between St. Helena and Walters Springs; provided, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Wallace B. Twitchell shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Wallace B. Twitchell has filed herein a certified copy of a permit issued by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. Helena in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
