ORDER

C. A. Kirkpatrick has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and express between Camp Wishon and Porterville and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge fares in accordance with a schedule filed as Exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding.

Applicant proposes to operate on a schedule of three round trips per week and to serve as an intermediate station the community of Springville.

The equipment proposed to be used in this service consists of one seven passenger Chandler Touring Car, 29 H. P., licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 261247.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public

convenience and necessity require the operation by C. A. Kirkpatrick of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and express between Camp Wishon and Porterville and intermediate points; provided, that this declaration shall not become effective until said C. A. Kirkpatrick shall have procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said C. A. Kirkpatrick has filed herein certified copies of permits from the Board of Supervisors of Tulare County and from the Board of Trustees of the City of Porterville; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written permission of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless said vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
