O R D E R

E. E. Tremain has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity requires the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and baggage between Groveland and Sequoia or Crocker's and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to establish a stage line between Groveland and Sequoia or Crocker's, connecting at Groveland with the stages of the Star Auto Stage Association and at Sequoia or Crocker's with the stages of Shaffer Brothers, the combination of lines forming a through service from Stockton to points in the Yosemite National Park. The proposed fares are contained in a schedule filed as Exhibit "A" with the application in this proceeding. A schedule of one round trip daily is proposed and same is to be in effect from July 1 to September 1 of each year.

The equipment proposed to be used in this service consists of two GMC eleven passenger automobiles, 28 H. P., licenses having been applied for to the State Motor Vehicle Department.

Permits in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917, have been granted by the Boards of Supervisors of Mariposa and Tuolumne Counties, as evidenced by certified copies thereof filed with the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity requires the operation by E. E. Tremain of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and baggage between Groveland and Sequoia or Crocker's and intermediate points; provided, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
