Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passing track, eleven hundred forty-nine (1149) feet in length, located at the Poppy Fields Stop on the Mount Lowe Line in the County of Los Angeles, such abandonment being sought for the reason that the track now serves no useful purpose and the material salvaged is useful at other locations on the lines of petitioner's system.

The track proposed to be abandoned and removed is fully shown on a blueprint map designated as M.W.H. 3601, marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding.

An inspection having been made and the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,
