BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

A. M. Fowler has petitioned the Railroad Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile stage service as a common carrier of passengers between Sacramento and Del Paso Park and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge fares in accordance with a schedule filed as Exhibit "A" with the application in this proceeding.

Applicant proposes to operate in accordance with a schedule filed with the application in this proceeding and to serve the intermediate communities at North Sacramento and Ben Ali, and to use as equipment one stage of special construction with 22 Horse-power engine and a seating capacity of fourteen passengers, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under license No. 292401.

Permit in accordance with Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917 has been issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento as evidenced by certified copy thereof which has been filed with the Railroad Commission.

The applicant is at present operating stage line between Sacramento and Ben Ali, and the certificate requested will enable an extension of such service to be made to Del Paso Park, which is owned and controlled by the City of Sacramento.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by A. M. Fowler of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Sacramento and Del Paso Park and intermediate points; provided, however, that the rights and privileges hereby granted may not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
