THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

SAN JOAQUIN LIGHT AND POWER CORPORATION having filed with the Railroad Commission statements showing that it has expended for construction purposes to June 30, 1918, the sum of \$137,624.03 against which no securities have been issued, and having asked the Railroad Commission for authority to use \$137,624.03 of the proceeds from the sale of the bonds authorized to be issued in Decision Number 5215, dated March 18, 1918, and Decision Number 5377, dated May 2, 1918, and it appearing to the Railroad Commission that of the expenditures referred to above, \$135,768.18 represents capital expenditures which may be properly paid from the proceeds from the sale of bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation be, and it is hereby, authorized to use \$135,768.18 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of bonds authorized to be issued pursuant to Decision Number 5215, dated March 18, 1918,

and Decision Number 5377, dated May 2, 1918, for the purpose of financing its capital expenditures prior to June 30, 1918, other than those expenditures incurred against estimates numbers 2645; 193; 194; 195 and 605.
