SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having by Decision Num-
ber 5383, dated May 8, 1918, as amended by Decision Number 5478,
dated June 11, 1918, authorized Murrieta Valley Elevator Company
to issue at par \$21,500.00 of its common capital stock for the
purpose of financing the construction of a grain elevator building
and the purchase of equipment; and Murrieta Valley Elevator Company
having filed in the above entitled matter a supplemental petition
wherein it asks authority to issue \$1,500.00 of its common capital
stock for the purpose of financing the construction of a spur track -
425.6 feet - to connect its elevator building with the lines of The
Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company; and the Engineering
Department of the Railroad Commission finding that the estimated
cost of said spur track, \$1,422.19, is reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Murrieta
Valley Elevator Company be, and it is hereby, granted authority
to issue at not less than par on or before November 1, 1918;

\$1,500.00 of its common capital stock for the purpose of financing the construction of the spur track referred to in the supplemental petition filed with the Railroad Commission on July 26, 1918, in the above entitled matter, provided that within thirty days after the issue of the stock herein authorized; applicant file with the Railroad Commission a statement showing the amount realized from the sale of said \$1,500.00 of stock and the purposes for which the proceeds have been expended.
