Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a spur track known as the "Naples Spur" and located on the Newport Beach Line, in Los Angeles County, for the reason that said spur track is alleged to serve no useful purpose and the material which might be salvaged if removal of the spur were to be authorized could be used at other locations.

The spur track for which abandonment has been requested is shown on a Blueprint marked MWH 2656, marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding.

An inspection having been made and the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
