O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of two spur tracks, 770 feet and 676 feet in length, respectively, located at Gayland Station on the Sawtelle Line in Los Angeles County.

The spur tracks proposed to be abandoned were installed to serve industrial plants, and said plants have discontinued their business activities at this location resulting in the tracks being of no further use to the shipping public.

The tracks proposed to be abandoned are fully shown on a blue print marked MWE 2053 and attached as Exhibit "A" to the application in this proceeding.

An investigation having been made and the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
