FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

The Railroad Commission HEREBY DECLARES that  
THE SOUTHERN SIERRAS POWER COMPANY has filed a stipulation as  
provided in the order heretofore made in this proceeding on  
March 29, 1918, which stipulation states that neither said  
company, its successors or assigns, will ever claim before the  
Railroad Commission, or any other public body, a value for the  
rights and privileges conferred in the franchise to be acquired  
from the BISHOP LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY, which franchise was  
granted by the Board of Supervisors of Inyo County on or about  
July 16, 1902, and a copy of which is attached to the stipula-  
tion, in excess of the amount actually paid to Inyo County as  
a consideration for the granting of said rights and privileges,

which amount is stated to be \$50.00.

The Railroad Commission HEREBY APPROVES the proposed bookkeeping entries filed by applicant in the above entitled matter on April 30, 1918, provided that said approval shall not be interpreted as a finding of value of any of the items of property referred to therein.
