BY THE COMMISSION

ORDER

A. C. Locey has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of a stage service as a common carrier of passengers and light freight between Chico and Cohasset.

Applicant has secured a contract for the carriage of United States mail between the terminals above mentioned and proposes to operate on a schedule of three round trips per week, charging a passenger fare of \$1.25 between terminals and a freight rate on the basis of fifty cents per hundred pounds. The equipment proposed to be used consists of a light two horse stage.

There is no other regular transportation service operating between the terminals on the proposed route and the service will meet a public demand.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by A. C. Locey

of a stage service as a common carrier of passengers and light freight between Chico and Cohasset; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said A. C. Lacey shall have procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said A. C. Lacey has filed herein certified copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Butte and the Board of Trustees of the City of Chico, as required by Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by said applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
