BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

William John Mills has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of a horse-drawn stage line as a common carrier of passengers and baggage between Tuolumne and Confidence.

Applicant proposes to charge fares in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding, and to operate on a schedule of one round-trip daily over the proposed route, using one two-horse stage as equipment.

Applicant holds a United States mail contract over the route for which certificate is requested and desires to carry such passenger and baggage traffic as may offer, there being no other regular transportation service on the proposed route.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by William John

Mills of a horse-drawn stage line between Tuolumne and Confidence as a common carrier of passengers and baggage; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Mills shall have procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Mills has filed herein certified copy of a permit issued by the Board of Supervisors of Tuolumne County in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
