BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

Elec Garcia has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, freight and baggage between Priest Valley, Lonoak and King City.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding, and to operate on a schedule of one round trip daily except Sunday between Lonoak and King City, and one round-trip on Tuesdays and Fridays of each week between Lonoak and Priest Valley.

The equipment proposed to be used consists of one Maxwell Touring Automobile, same to be used unless the roads are impassable during winter months, in which case horse drawn vehicles will be substituted.

Applicant holds a contract for the transportation of United States mail over the proposed route and desires to serve the traffic needs of the population residing along the route, there being no regularly established transportation service

other than that proposed by applicant herein.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Elec Garcia of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, freight and baggage between Priest Valley, Lonoak and King City, provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Garcia shall have procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Garcia has filed herein certified copies of permits issued by the Boards of Supervisors of the Counties of Monterey and San Benito and the Board of Trustees of the City of King City; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer shall have first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
