BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

William R. Markt has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between the San Francisco County Line and the City of South San Francisco and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule filed as exhibit "A" with the application in this proceeding, and to operate on a schedule of three round trips daily using as equipment one Studebaker automobile bus with seating capacity of sixteen passengers, forty horse-power, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 398584.

The proposed service is over a route not now served by any automobile transportation company and its establishment will relieve cause for complaint as to inadequate transportation facilities, especially as regards the movement of employees of the Shaw-Batcher ship building plant and the rate schedule proposed by applicant provides a commutation rate for

patrons to and from such industrial plant.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by William R. Markt of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between the San Francisco County Line and South San Francisco and intermediate points; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said William R. Markt shall have procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said William R. Markt has filed herein certified copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County and by the Board of Trustees of the City of South San Francisco in accordance with the requirements of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless said vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
