BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

Wm. L. Walter has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Bradley and Bryson and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding, and to operate on a schedule of one round-trip daily, except Sundays, serving the intermediate community at Pleyto.

The equipment proposed to be used consists of one Ford Automobile, 22 H. P.

Applicant holds a United States Mail contract over the proposed route and desires to be allowed the privilege of carrying passengers in connection with the mail, there being no other regular transportation service available to the public over the proposed route.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Wm. L. Walter of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Bradley and Bryson and intermediate points; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Wm. L. Walter shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein declaring that said Wm. L. Walter has filed herein certified copy of permit issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be transferred or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
