BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

Wm. H. Anderson has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, packages and baggage between Randsburg and Trona.

Applicant proposes to charge fares in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of one round trip daily, using as equipment one Briscoe Automobile, 16 H. P., five passenger capacity, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 59341,

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Wm. H. Anderson of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, packages and baggage between Randsburg and Trona;

provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Wm. H. Anderson shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Wm. H. Anderson has filed herein certified copies of permit issued by the Boards of Supervisors of the Counties of Kern and San Bernardino in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
