BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision Number 5674, dated August 10, 1918, authorized East Bay Water Company to issue \$1,250,000 of 5-year 6 per cent notes due August 1, 1923, and issue and pledge bonds, and

WHEREAS, East Bay Water Company on October 8, 1918, filed with the Railroad Commission a copy of its proposed trust agreement defining the terms and conditions under which said notes are to be issued and said bonds pledged, said trust agreement for purposes of identification having been marked "Applicant's Exhibit Number 1"; and

Good Cause Appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that East Bay Water Company be, and the same is hereby, authorized to execute a trust agreement substantially in the same form as the agreement filed with the Railroad Commission on October 8, 1918 and marked "Applicant's Exhibit Number 1".

The approval herein given of said trust agreement is for the purpose of this proceeding only and an approval in so far as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities, and is not intended as an approval of said trust agreement as to such other legal requirements to which said trust agreement may be subject.
