In the matter of the application of the State Warehouse Company for authority to increase and adjust warehouse rates at Stockton, Marysville, Chico and South Vallejo.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, the Railroad Commission in Decision No.
4910 dated November 30, 1917, authorized State Warehouse Company
to make certain increases in its warehouse rates applicable at
Stockton, Marysville and Chico: and

Whereas, it was understood that the rates so authorized and applicable at Marysville covered commodities stored only on the ground floor, the upper story of applicant's warehouse not being equipped at that time for storage purposes; and

Whereas, owing to a scarcity of warehouse space and insistent demands of growers in the vicinity of Marysville, applicant has at considerable expense installed facilities for receiving and handling commodities on the upper floor of its warehouse; and

Whereas, State Warehouse Company has filed a supplemental application requesting authority to fix and establish an additional charge of 25 cents per ton for receiving, weighing, trucking, elevating and piling commodities stored in said upper story of its warehouse and 25 cents per ton for delivering, trucking, and loading into cars such commodities so stored; and

Whereas, in addition to the increased cost of handling commodities requiring elevator service, it is common knowledge that labor motority costs more now than in 1917, improvementable.

Whereas, under the above statement of facts the Commission believes that a public hearing is not necessary in this case, but that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that State Warehouse Company be, and the same is hereby granted authority to publish and file within twenty days from date hereof a supplement to its present warehouse tariff showing the following rates for warehouse service in connection with commodities stored above the ground floor in its warehouse located at Marysville:

Warehouse Rates -- Upper Floor Service

For service of receiving, elevating

and piling commodities, 25¢ per ton.

For the service of delivering and

loading commodities into cars..... 25¢ per ton.
