BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

W. F. Davis has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between San Lucas and Lockwood, in the County of Monterey.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of one round-trip daily using as equipment a Ford Touring car with seating capacity of five persons.

Applicant holds the United States mail contract between San Lucas and Lockwood and desires the privilege of carrying passengers, baggage and freight in connection with the mail over the proposed route, there being no other established transportation service available for the public use.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public

convenience and necessity require the operation by W. F. Davis of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, baggage and freight between San Lucas and Lockwood; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said W. F. Davis shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said W. F. Davis has filed herein certified copy of permit issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
