SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

San Joaquin Light & Power Corporation having filed with the Railroad Commission statements showing that it has expended for construction from September 1, 1918 to September 30, 1918, both dates inclusive, the sum of \$114,672.45, and having asked the Railroad Commission for authority to use the proceeds of \$114,672.45 face value of Series "C" 6 per cent bonds authorized to be issued by Decisions Numbers 5215 and 5377 and Decision Number 5618, to finance said construction expenditures, and it appearing to the Railroad Commission that of the expenditures referred to \$112,551.45 represents capital expenditures which may be properly paid from the proceeds of bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Joaquin Light & Power Corporation be, and it is hereby, authorized to use the proceeds from \$112,551.45 of Series "C" 6 per cent bonds authorized to be issued pursuant to Decision Number 5215, dated March 18, 1918, Decision Number 5377, dated May 2, 1918 and Decision Number 5618, dated July 22, 1918 for the purpose of financing its capital expenditures from September 1, 1918 to September 30, 1918, both dates inclusive, other than those expenditures incurred against Estimates Numbers 193; 194; 195; 498; 499; 605 and 2643.
