O R D E R

Nativo Celayo has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and baggage between Angels Camp and Murphys and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding, and to operate on a schedule of one round trip daily serving the intermediate communities at Vallecita and Douglas Flat.

The equipment proposed to be used consists of one Ford Auto Truck, 42HP., seating capacity four passengers and of 1/2 ton weight capacity, licensed by the State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 420361.

Applicant has a contract for the carriage of United States mail between Angels Camp and Murphys and desires the privilege of accommodating the limited passenger traffic offering over the proposed route.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Nativio Celayo of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and baggage between Angels Camp and Murphys and intermediate points; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Nativio Celayo shall have procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Nativio Celayo has filed herein certified copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras and the Board of Trustees of the City of Angels; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
