BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

Wm. A. Herman has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of a stage service as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Briceland and Shelter Cove.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of one round trip on Tuesdays and Fridays of each week, using as equipment one two-horse stage.

Applicant is the contractor for the carriage of United States mail over the proposed route and desires the privilege of handling passengers and light freight in addition to his mail contract, there being no other regular transportation service available for the public over the proposed route.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Wm. A. Herman

of a stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Briceland and Shelter Cove; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Wm. A. Herman has procured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Wm. A. Herman has filed herein certified copy of permit issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
