FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Order in Decision Number 4882, dated November 27, 1917, (Vol. 14, Opinions and Orders of the Railroad Commission of California, page 567), provides that Saticoy Warehouse Company shall expend the proceeds from the sale of 63 shares of stock only for such purposes as the Railroad Commission may approve in a supplemental order or orders; and

WHEREAS, Saticoy Warehouse Company reports that it owes the Peoples Lumber Company \$2,432.09 for material purchased and used in the construction of its warehouse; and

WHEREAS, Saticoy Warehouse Company asks permission to use part of the proceeds from the sale of its stock to pay its indebtedness due the Peoples Lumber Company;

And Good Cause Appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Saticoy Warehouse Company do, and it is hereby, granted authority to use \$2,432.09 of the proceeds from the sale of its capital stock to pay the \$2,432.09 indebtedness due Peoples Lumber Company, said indebtedness representing the cost of material purchased and used by applicant in the construction of its warehouse.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Order in Decision Number 4882, dated November 27, 1917, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
