ORDER

Trueman E. Rigney has petitioned the Railroad Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate automobile stage service between San Andreas, Angels Camp, Valley Springs, Sheep Ranch and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with schodules marked Exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate a schedule of one round trip daily between the terminal points serving as intermediates the communities at Fourth Crossing. North Branch and Mountain Ranch.

There is no other regular transportation available for the public over the proposed mute, and we are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RATIROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECTARES that public convenience and necessity requires the operation by Trueman E. Rigney of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between San Andreas, Angels Camp, Valley Springs, Sheep Ranch and intermediate points; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Trueman E.

Rigney shall have received from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Trueman E. Rigney has filed with the Railroad Commission certified copy of permit granted by the Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges hereby granted shall not be transferred nor assigned unless the written permission of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
