BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

GEORGE BERG and LILY BERG having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer to B. E. Kell, for the sum of \$1600.00, a certain telephone system in San Benito County, California, known as the George Berg telephone line, said line running from the home now or formerly owned by the said George Berg, located on the west half of Section twenty-five in Township fifteen South, Range ten East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, in the County of San Benito, State of California, to the New Idria Mine and thence on to the Aurora Mine, a distance of about 2 miles, also a two mile extension to the San Carlos Oil Wells; and a branch line of 1½ miles to the Old Geo. Weaver place; in all, about 25 miles of telephone line, fifteen telephones belonging to line, together with all switch-boards, instruments, poles, attachments, and materials belonging to the said telephone line.

Together with all rights of way incident to said telephone line, including the following:

That certain franchise or permit granted to George Berg by the Board of Supervisors of San Benito County, California, on November 7, 1905, as shown by the minutes of said Board of Supervisors of that date, reference to which is hereby made;

Also all rights granted by E. Larios to said George Berg under deed dated March 6, 1906, duly recorded in Book 37 of Deeds, page 40, Records of San Benito County, California, which is hereby referred to and made a part hereof;

Also all rights granted by W. J. Curtner to George Berg under agreement dated November 27, 1905, duly recorded in Book 37 of Deeds, page 41, Records of San Benito County, California, which is hereby referred to and made a part hereof:

Also all rights granted by Manuel Gonzales to George Berg, by deed dated March 6, 1906, duly recorded in Book 37 of Deeds, page 42, Records of San Benito County, California, which is hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

Also all rights granted by John Ashurst to George Berg, by deed dated April 3, 1906, and duly recorded in Book 37 of Deeds, page 43, Records of San Benito County, California, which is hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

And it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said application be, and the same hereby is granted on the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted to transfer shall apply only to such conveyance as is made on or before June 30, 1919.

2. Upon the transfer of any property herein authorized to be transferred a statement to that effect, together with a copy of the deed of transfer shall be filed with the Railroad Commission.
