ORDER

The UNITED STATES SHIPPING BOARD EMERGENCY FLEET CORPOR-
 ATION, by the San Diego Electric Railway Company, a corporation,
 having, on December 2, 1918, filed an application with the Commission
 for permission to construct a crossing at grade over the tracks
 of the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company, at the intersection
 of Thirty-second Street with Grand Avenue, in the City of San Diego,
 County of San Diego, State of California, as more particularly de-
 scribed in the application and as shown by the map attached thereto;
 and it appearing that this is not a case in which a public hearing
 is necessary; that the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company has
 granted its permission for the necessary construction to be made;
 and it further appearing that it is not reasonable not practicable
 to avoid a grade crossing at the intersection of said street and
 avenue, and that this application should be granted subject to the
 conditions hereinafter specified;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be and the same is

hereby granted the SAN DIEGO ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, for the UNITED STATES SHIPPING BOARD EMERGENCY FLEET CORPORATION, to construct a crossing at grade over the tracks of the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company, at the intersection of Thirty-second Street with Grand Avenue, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, as more particularly described in the application and as shown by the map attached thereto; said crossing to be constructed subject to the following conditions, viz.:

(1) The crossing shall be constructed and maintained in accordance with the agreement between the companies hereinbefore referred to.

(2) All ~~engines~~ trains, motors and cars of applicant and the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company shall come to a full stop before passing over this crossing, and shall not proceed to cross until they have ascertained that it is safe to do so.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
