FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

SUTTER BUTTE CANAL COMPANY having advised the Railroad Commission that it does not at this time desire to issue the bonds authorized by the order in Decision Number 6034, dated December 28, 1918, for the purpose of paying or refunding the \$350,000 of 6 per cent Sutter Butte Canal Company bonds due March 1, 1931;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREEY ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 6034, dated December 28, 1918, be, and it is hereby, amended so as to permit Sutter Butte Canal Company to issue only \$432,000 of its first refunding 6 per cent 20-year gold bonds payable March 1, 1939 (bonds numbered 1 to 432 inclusive) for the purposes and under the conditions set forth in said order, except that none of the \$432,000 of bonds shall be used to pay or refund the \$350,000 of 6 per cent Sutter Butte Canal Company bonds due March 1, 1931, it being understood that said \$350,000 of bonds will be paid or refunded through the issue, if necessary, of applicant's first refunding 6 per cent 20-year gold bonds payable March 1, 1939, numbered 433 to 800 inclusive, as may be hereafter authorized by

the Railroad Commission in a supplemental order or orders in this proceeding.

IT IS HERERY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 6034, dated December 28, 1918, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
