SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, California Telephone and Light Com-  
pany has filed with this Commission a supplemental ap-  
plication requesting that it be authorized to apply  
the surcharge as fixed in this Commission's Decision  
No. 5711 to the bills for service delivered to the  
City of Healdsburg, and,

WHEREAS it appears reasonable that, from  
consideration of the evidence introduced in the above

entitled matter, a surcharge of 2 mills per kilowatt hour should be applied to bills for service rendered to the City of Healdsburg,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that California Telephone and Light Company be and the same is hereby authorized to charge and collect for electric energy sold to the City of Healdsburg, in addition to its regular charges, a surcharge of 2 mills per kilowatt hour, based upon regular meter readings taken on and after January 15th, 1919.
