FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS it appears that Southern California Edison Company and its predecessor, Pacific Light and Power Corporation, formerly charged a minimum for electric lighting service in the cities of Tropic, Arcadia, San Gabriel and San Marino of 50 cents per meter per month, and

WHEREAS, by inadvertance, these cities were not included in the list of those set forth in Decision No. 6000, in which the minimum should be 75 cents per meter per month,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 6000 in the above entitled application be

and the same is hereby modified to the effect that Southern California Edison Company be and the same is ordered to charge and collect a minimum charge for electric lighting service of 75 cents per meter per month in the cities of Arcadia, San Gabriel, San Marino and that portion of the City of Glendale formerly the City of Tropico, for all meter readings taken on and after January 2nd, 1919.
