## O R D E R

Pickwick Stages, Northern Division, a corporation, has applied to the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by it of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and express packages between Los Angeles and Camarillo and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of one round trip daily serving the intermediate communities at Chatsworth, Santa Susana, Simi and Moorpark.

There is no regular stage transportation service available between the termini and over the route herein requested and we are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by the Pickwick

Stages, Northern Division, a corporation, of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and express packages between Los Angeles and Comarillo and intermediate points; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Pickwick Stages, Northern Division, shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Pickwick Stages, Northern Division, have filed herein certified copies of permits granted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles and the Board of Public Utilities of the City of Los Angeles; and provided further that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment will have first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this permit unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
