## ORDER.

EDGAR C. CHAPMAN has applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to sell and transfer to the MARIN MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT a certain water distributing system at Chapman Park, Marin County, California, consisting of water pipe lines, two 10,000 gallon wooden tanks and an electric pumping plant. Also, certain pipe lines laid in the streets, avenues, roads, lanes and alleys of the Town of Corte Madera, in said County of Marin. Applicant requests that said sale and transfer be deemed to have taken place as of September 1, 1918, in order that the income to be derived from the operation of said water distributing system may be available to said Marin Municipal Water District on and after said date.

Marin Municipal Water District having joined in the

application and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application be and the same is hereby granted, provided that when a conveyance of the property is made in accordance with this order, a certified copy thereof shall, within 15 days, be filed with the Railroad Commission.
