Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a spur track 408 feet in length, same located in the City of Santa Monica, which is no longer used in connection with the operation of the railroad of the applicant, the spur track proposed to be removed being more fully illustrated on a blue print map designated as "LME 2989" and filed as exhibit "A" with the application in this proceeding.
