O R D E R

Henry A. Condra has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Los Alamitos and Seal Beach.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of four round trips, daily except Sunday, using as equipment one 1916 model Studebaker Automobile, seven passenger capacity, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under license No. 69488.

Applicant holds a contract for the carriage of United States mail over the proposed route and desires the privilege of carrying passengers in connection with his mail contract. The proposed route is served as intermediate by the Rose Stage Line, but the schedule proposed by applicant will not conflict with the schedule of the Rose line and the service proposed to be rendered will be an accommodation to the traveling public.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Henry A. Condra of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Los Alamitos and Seal Beach and intermediate points; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said Henry A. Condra shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Henry A. Condra has filed herein certified copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Orange and the Board of Trustees of the City of Seal Beach in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this permit unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
