O R D E R

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, having on January 11, 1919, filed with the Commission an application for permission to install a grade crossing over the tracks of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company on an unnamed road between Los Nietos and Rivera, said road to be known as Hamlin Road, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown by the map attached to the application; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has granted the easement necessary for the construction to be made; and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said road, and that this application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be and the same is hereby granted the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, to install a grade crossing over the tracks of
