In the Matter of the Application of Southern Pacific Company for authority to advance switching charges in Items Nos. 67-C, 68-B, 69-C, 150-1-A, 150-2-A, 212-2, 212-3-A, 217-B, 219-A, 223, 232-1-A, 257-1, of C.R.C. No. 1260. Southern Pacific Company's Terminal Tariff No. 230-G, and to cancel from same tariff Items Nos. 193, 194, 195, 197-B, 198-A, 199, 204-A and 259. The principal effect of the application will be to make the interyard switching 50 cents per ton, minimum of \$7.50 instead of 25 cents with minimum of \$5.00.
