FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY having filed with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of Ordinance Number 49 of the City of El Segundo, referred to in Decision Number 6104, dated February 13, 1919, and a stipulation in which Southern California Gas Company agrees that it will never claim before the Railroad Commission, or any court or other public body, a value for the rights and privileges secured under Ordinance Number 49 in excess of the actual cost, which cost is reported at \$275.00, and said ordinance and stipulation being in satisfactory form;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Railroad Commission of the State of California HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY of the rights and privileges conferred by Ordinance Number 49 of the City of El Segundo, passed and approved on February 19, 1919, by the Board of Trustees of said City of El Segundo.
